I'm sharing this information with you because the Meyers-Briggs and the Enneagram are my two favorite personality typing assessments to create characters. How I use these two systems is like this:

- 1. Think about the general personality of your character. Just make up some basic details to help you narrow down your selection.
- 2. Find the closest personality type in the Meyers-Briggs. I've only provided links because there is A LOT of information to sort through.
- 3.Once you have all the information you want/need for your character, use the guide at the bottom of the character profile sheet to help you find the most relevant Enneagram type.
- 4. Now use the Meyers-Briggs to help you understand how your character will react in different situations or how he will move through life and interact with other people.
- 5. Use the Enneagram to help you nail down how the the character will react emotionally to the obstacles and situations you throw them into.

If you're thinking that you're character is going to be super unique and not like the others, I promise it's not. These personality typing tests exist for a reason. You don't need to pigeon-hole yourself, but these are great guides to help characters feel real/genuine to your readers.
